Rules for RiverTree - Quick Reference

Post these in your home or RV; share these with your guests; review these with guests/family frequently

Gate entrance and exit

- ✓ Gate device (remote or key) REQUIRED to ENTER and EXIT RiverTree
- ✓ In the event of a MEDICAL EMERGENCY, CALL 911 for local EMS response.
 - o Tell Dispatch you are in RiverTree on Hwy 83 South of Leakey.
 - o Provide your RiverTree 911 address if you have it.
- ✓ All emergency response, volunteer fire dept., law enforcement, and utility companies have 24 hour gate entrance access in the event of an emergency.

Private Property

- ✓ ALL LOTS within RiverTree are <u>Private Property</u>, with the exception of the Common Areas, i.e., paved roads, hike/bike/walking trails, pavilion, river park, and RV Pit.
- ✓ Owners who encounter individuals intentionally trespassing on their property are DIRECTED TO CALL
 911 to report the incident and request law enforcement assistance.
- ✓ The BOD recommends that individual owners post signs on your property stating: "POSTED NO TRESPASSING".

Off-Road Vehicles (ORV) & Licensed Vehicles

- ✓ Only "permitted" ORVs allowed in RiverTree; register and post # on ORV prior to use. See BOD Treasurer for registration forms.
- ✓ Only battery operated ORVs allowed on hike/bike trails
- ✓ No ORVs allowed in trailer pit except for dumping trash in garbage containers
- ✓ No ORVs around pavilion except to use facilities
- ✓ Motorized ORVs & licensed vehicles allowed on paved roads only
- ✓ ORVs must have lights turned on after dark
- ✓ No off-roading is allowed except on the property of the owner of the ORV
- √ No licensed vehicle off-roading is allowed on any property.
- \checkmark No dragging of limbs or other debris on paved roads.
- √ No dragging or towing of objects designed for non-road activities on paved roads.

Park Rules

- ✓ No glass containers allowed in Park or Riverbed
- ✓ No Licensed Vehicles or ORVs allowed inside River park area. (special needs only & Emergency services)
- ✓ Please pick up and take trash with you when you leave
- ✓ Pets on a leash in RiverTree at all times. This includes the River Park.
- ✓ Be considerate of private property on either side of the park and from the midline of the river to the opposite bank

Rules for RiverTree - Quick Reference

Post these in your home or RV; share these with your guests; review these with guests/family frequently

Green Garbage Dumpsters - RV Pit

- ✓ <u>Please</u>, only put household garbage in dumpsters
- ✓ No metal, hazardous materials, tires, paint, etc.
- √ No roofing or building material or brush
- ✓ Boxes should be folded or cut up
- ✓ Leakey has several Thrift Stores that will gladly take your, in good condition: furniture, household goods, bedding, working electronics & appliances, etc. Re-purpose it....don't toss it.

<u>Lighting--</u> Please be sure all exterior lights are off when:

- ✓ You leave
- √ You go to bed
- √ Not needed

Excessive Noise- Please be considerate of your neighbors:

- ✓ When playing music
- ✓ Having a party
- ✓ Loud off-road vehicles

Pets: All pets must be on a leash at all times except when they are confined within the premises of the lot owner

Recreational Vehicles

- ✓ Cannot be left unoccupied or unattended on the majority of RiverTree property.
- √ RV/tent camper/tent can remain in place on your property, while continuously occupied, for a 30 day period.
- √ At end of 30 day period, RV/tent camper/tent must be moved off your property for a 24 hour period, before it can be set up again on your property.
- ✓ The unit can be moved to a site approved by the BOD, an assigned site in the RiverTree RV Pit, or taken outside RiverTree to another storage or camp facility.
- ✓ If you need a space in the RV Pit, contact the BOD President or Treasurer.
- ✓ Owners with assigned RV Pit spaces are responsible for the property maintenance of that space.
